



Shanghai Summer School 2017

Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship Program
Hosted by Shanghai International Studies University (SISU)

Brief Introduction:

Shanghai Summer School, abbreviated as 3S, is a scholarship program provided by Shanghai Municipal Government, aiming to encourage more foreign young people to come to China, to learn the language and experience the culture. Entrusted by Shanghai Municipal Education Commission, Shanghai International Studies University (SISU) has hosted successfully since 2010 one of the 3S programs which recruits outstanding students from **Spanish-speaker countries**.

Duration:

From July 3 to August 11, 2017 (6 weeks).

Place:

Hongkou Campus of SISU.

Study Plan & Extracurricular Activities:

- Chinese courses (including grammar, conversation, listening comprehension, etc.), 20 teaching hours per week, 4 teaching hours each morning (8:30-11:50), Monday through Friday.
- Additional courses of Chinese Culture Practice, such as Chinese Traditional Calligraphy, Artistic Paper Cutting, Taijiquan (shadow boxing).
- Lectures on Comparison between Chinese and Spanish, Chinese history and culture, Chinese contemporary economic development, economic opening-up and reform, China's diplomatic and international strategies, Shanghai history etc.
- Inner city visit to Shanghai Museum, Yuyuan Garden, and acrobatics show etc.
- Weekend cultural experience
- Extra-curriculum activities with Chinese students.

★ Contents of teaching and activities may be adjusted as needed

- Application fee & Tuition & Teaching Materials
- Accommodation (double room at SISU's International Students' Residence)
- Cultural Experience Visits organized by SISU
- The school dining (provided in the form of a meal ticket or cash)

Admission Qualifications:

Senior high school graduates, with or without Chinese proficiency, over 18 and under 40 years old, in good health, and with reliable financial support and custody.

May 15, 2017.
